- 1b) Broadcast listeners who log broadcast stations from Africa, America, Asia, Australia and Europe.

- 2) Joker
QSO with Prof. Braun Day DL0PFB, Lizard GB2LD, Poldhu GB2GM, and Villa Griffone IY4FGM count as a 'Joker' for a country.

- 3) Application
Number 1a: Log of qso data (date, time, call, rapport)
Number 1b: Log of date, time, station, frequency and type of programme.
